- 1. Approval of Minutes from October & Nov. 2012 Meeting- approved
- 2. Reports
- Treasurers report (K. Wilson) including delinquency report
   End of 2012 funds \$67,815, \$40102 in reserve accounts
   2012 revenues exceeded budget forecast by \$4,320. Expenditures \$9,810 under budget.
  - 2 properties delinquent both have Association liens and unit 41 in association foreclosure
- Community rounds Doug had list of problem properties and was authorized to select 10 to receive notices of violation.
- ACC report -1212 Huntington Lane has proceeded with addition.
- Ponds report Presentation Armstrong Environmental Services (new pond company).
  Report delayed to February meeting
- Web site no activity for 3 months. The HOA is requesting Ameritech to reduce web fee 50%. Alternatively the association is considering going off on its own again.
   Newsletter – Lisa Hinton – reminder again re: pet clean-up – no more than 2 dogs per household (acc. to deed restrictions)
- 3. Continuing business.
  - Entrance refurbishment project completed except for new plantings.
  - Some sprinkler heads need to be repaired per Landscape Contractor to John Evans John authorized to test sprinkler system and make repairs as needed.
  - Sidewalks The Board authorized a contract with Dol-fan construction to make sidewalk repairs in the amount of \$5,320. The Board turned down Do-fan construction's request for a down payment prior to the start of work.
  - John Evans suggests removal of overgrown oleanders on 1st Marshall St. entrance.
    Doug will work with John and bring forth a recommendation at the February meeting Perimeter wall and island mulch estimates will be requested of John Evans.
