Approximately 2,000 people attend Harborside each Sunday, the corresponding traffic should stay on McMullen Booth and not disrupt the Huntington Communities. If you attend Harborside and do not like the impact the access drive would have on our community, it would be appreciated that you voice your objections to the Harborside leadership.
