# Did you know we pay for the electricity running the community street lamps?

Around \$1,000 per month! It is our largest recurring monthly expense. It is very important to report lights that are continually on during the day or that are out at night to Progress Energy. The lights can be reported by calling 800-228-8485 and pressing 3 from the voice menu or visiting the website progress-energy.com/streetlightrepair and filling out the outage form. Each light pole has a unique several-digit number that identifies its location, however, the number is not necessary to report the problem.



#### Save The Bushes

We will soon be replacing the dead and dying bushes around the Huntington Trails' perimeter wall. Please do not discharge chlorinated pool water thru the wall holes onto the bushes. It is killing them. Thank you, in advance, for your cooperation.
