

PERIMETER WALL REPAIR AND CLEANING - OCTOBER

We will be repairing and painting the community's surrounding perimeter wall. Both the interior and exterior wall will be repaired and painted. If you live along the perimeter wall: access to your backyard will be needed, objects moved away from wall and any plants or trees that block the wall inside your yard must be trimmed to allow for access to the wall. We will give 30 days notice. Our current estimate is to have work done sometime in October.

NO POLITICAL SIGNS IN YARDS

During this election season, please keep in mind that it is a violation of our deed restrictions to post political signs in your yard. Article II, Section 3: No sign or billboard of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any portion of any Lot, except one (1) sign for each building site, of not more than eighteen (18) inches by twenty-four (24) inches, advertising the property for sale or rent, or except signs used by Declarant to advertise the properties during the construction and sales period, or except as approved by the Architectural Committee.
