1. Call to order at 6:05pm and verify quorum.

2. Approval of minutes from Budget Board Meeting 11-26-2024

3. Reports:
 - a. Treasurer's report – income, operating funds, reserves, delinquent assessments.
 - i. See attached Treasurers Report \$32,378.86 in operating account and \$187,132.90 in reserve account. End of year gain of \$13,555.30. One home in collections for past dues.
 - b. Manager's report – Ameritech Community Association Online portal is where information is being entered, and we can ask for a report any time. Managers will get reminders of tasks.
 - i. Deed restriction rounds/discussion - Jenny Kidd of Ameritech 3 homes over 90 days behind on HOA dues and one is in the attorneys' hands with a lien on the property and it could be put in foreclosure. Decided to hold for a month on the 3 homes that are just over 90 days.
 - ii. Violation notices. Closed a few violation notices.
Wrote a couple of escalation letters today.
We sent an email re: picking up after your pets.
Sign post repairs are in process.
Send a general email about cleaning your roof.
We can send violation notices if we see homeowners blowing yard debris into the street.
 - iii. Architectural report: report from Jenny Kidd & Kim Geiss
 - c. Ponds report – Nicole Dommer
 - i. Tigris was onsite on 12-30-24 Nicole spoke with them stating they must be visiting regularly, not 6 weeks in between.
 1. Treated new invasive shoreline vegetation as needed (1-3).

2. Treated algae (1-3) due to low water levels/landscape waste in sites.
3. Picked up trash as necessary.
- ii. Tigris onsite 1-16-25 [Nicole spoke with them about City of Safety Harbor report. Emailed the report to them and they will start working on the grasses that are in the pond. The prior pond company indicated the grasses would be good. The City indicated they are not good and so did the current pond company.](#)
 1. Treated for minimal algae and invasive shoreline vegetation
 2. Very little trash to pick up
 3. Ponds look good even with the lack of water
